

Donald Guy Trammell, Jr.

July 11, 1931 - October 18, 2017

Mr. Donald Guy Trammell, Jr., age 86, of Rome, went to be with Jesus Wednesday afternoon, October 18, 2017 in a local health care facility.

A native of Rome, Mr. Trammell was born July 11, 1931, son of the late Donald Guy Trammell, Sr. and Inez Holland Trammell. He was a graduate of Rome High School and the School of Consumer Banking at the University of Virginia. In 1948, he began his career with The National City Bank of Rome as a bookkeeper, and retired in 1986 as Senior Vice President and Cashier. Mr. Trammell was a veteran of the U.S. Marine Corps during the Korean War. He was an adult Sunday school teacher for many years, an active supporter of the Salvation Army, and a deacon at Parkview Baptist Church. Mr. Trammell was a skilled wood-worker and handyman. He served as Scoutmaster for Troop 25, Boy Scouts of America and a member of the Northwest Georgia Council, where he received the Silver Beaver Award.

Survivors include his wife, Cecilia Cooper Trammell, to whom he was married April 9, 1955; four children, Beth, Donald (Renee), Susan and Bill (Karen) Trammell; four grandchildren, Lissa (Nathan) Crowe, Emmie and Claire Trammell, and Joey Trammell; and two great grandchildren, Cohen and Kara Crowe.
